3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to do the floor and household cleaning, cooking, laundry and ironing, sewing and beds preparation, selecting and using the techniques, tools, products and facilities to ensure the sanitation of the home and permit the availability of beds, household linen, clothing, and food provision, complying with the occupational risk prevention regulation. This general competence is divided into the following **skill units**(UC):

- Carry out the cleaning of a private home, within the employers' household (UC1330_1).
- Carry out the food processing process in all their stages of shopping, organization, handling, cooking and preservation, in a household (UC1331_1).
- Carry out the laundry, ironing and basic sewing of clothing and household linen, and rooms tidiness in households (UC1332_1).

The professional skills are acquired through the **learning outcomes** defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Household cleaning (MF1330_1).
- Domestic cooking (MF1331_1).
- Preparation of beds, clothing and household linen (MF1332_1).
- Practical training at the workplace in domestic work (MP0141).

(See legal basis for all learning outcomes information acquired by the holder of this Certificate in each MF).

As a reference, the learning outcomes include in the Practical training that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:

- Clean the furniture and objects of a private home.
- Do the provision and preservation of food and household products.
- Carry out the menu processing operations and prepare it according to the characteristics and needs of the diners.
- Carry out the washing, sewing and ironing of clothings.
- Carry out beds preparation.
- Participate in the working processes of the company, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of this certificate may work in the domestic sector in the following productive activities: cleaning and housekeeping, laundry, ironing, basic manual sewing of clothing and household linens, bed preparation and food provision and basic cooking. The most relevant occupations and work positions are:

- Domestic cooker.
- Home worker.
- Domestic cleaner.
- Domestic ironer.

5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE

Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate

The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.

Level of the certificate

The Professional Certificate Level 1 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 2 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).

The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:

Grading scale/Pass requirements

The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module.

The grading system is as follows:

- FAIL: 0 to 4.9
- PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9
- PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9
- PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10

Access to next level of education/training

This Professional Certificate Level 1 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 2 within the same professional area and family.

For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.

Legal basis

Royal Decree 721/2011, of May 20th, by which four professional certificates of the professional family "Sociocultural and community services", included in the National Repertoire of professional certificates, and the professional certificates established as appendix I and II of Royal Decree 1379/2008, of August 1st) are updated. 6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

This certificate may be acquired by:

1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme.
2. Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate.
3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate.

The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:

Additional information: Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
