3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to perform work of burial, exhumation and reduction of dead bodies, body parts and/or human-ash, as well as cleanup of the cemetery and maintenance of gardens, parks and green areas taking in consideration labour risks and environmental protection regulations and mortuary health risks, to meet the requirements of the cemeteries services. This general competence is divided into the following **skill units**(UC):

- Carry out burial, exhumation and reduction of dead bodies, body parts and/or human-ashes (UC2006_1).
- Carry out the cleaning of cemeteries (UC2007_1).
- Perform auxiliary operations for the maintenance of gardens, parks and green areas (UC0522_1).

The professional skills are acquired through the **learning outcomes** defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Burial, exhumation and reduction of dead bodies, body parts and/or human-ashes (MF2006_1).
- Cemeteries cleaning (MF2007_1).
- Basic maintenance operations of gardens, parks and green areas (MF0522_1).
- Practical training at the workplace in funeral and maintenance activities in cemeteries (MP0506).

As a reference the learning outcomes include in the Practical training at the workplace that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:

- Carry out basic operations with burial units using appropriate tools, applying labour risk prevention measures and mortuary health police regulation.
- Carry out cleaning operations at the cemetery and related facilities, using appropriate tools and applying labour risk prevention measures and environmental regulations.
- Carry out basic maintenance of lawns and other grass, using appropriate equipment and applying labour risk prevention measures and environmental regulations.
- Participate in the working processes of the company, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of this certificate may work in the funeral industry: in cemeteries and graveyards authorized for burial, exhumation and reduction. The most relevant occupations and work positions are:

- Gravedigger.
- Garden and green areas worker.
- Cemetery worker.
- Road cleaning and related worker.

5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE

Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate

The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.

Level of the certificate

The Professional Certificate Level 1 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 2 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).

The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:

Grading scale/Pass requirements

The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module.

The grading system is as follows:

- FAIL: 0 to 4.9
- PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9
- PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9
- PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10

Access to next level of education/training

This Professional Certificate Level 1 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 2 within the same professional area and family.

For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.

Legal basis

Royal Decree 990/2013 of December 13th, by which six professional certificates of the professional family Sociocultural and Community Services included in the National Repertoire of professional certificates are established, and a professional certificate of the professional family Food industry, established in Royal Decree 646/2011, of May 9th (Appendix I, Code: SSCI0212) is updated.

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

This certificate may be acquired by:

1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme.
2. Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate.
3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate.

The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:

Additional information: Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
