3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to carry out artistic silk screen printing, creating or using sketches, obtaining the stencils, transparencies and screens, preparing the materials needed and adjusting the elements in the printing process, carrying out all the operations in conditions of occupational safety and environmental protection. This general competence is divided into the following **skills units** (UC):

- Prepare and use sketches for graphic work (UC0687_2).
- Create stencils and transparencies for artistic silk screen printing (UC2101_2).
- Obtain screens for artistic silk screen printing (UC2102_2).
- Print in artistic silk screen printing (UC2103_2).

The professional skills are acquired through the **learning outcomes** defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Techniques of expression in graphic work (MF0687_2).
- Photomechanical techniques and obtaining stencils (MF2101_2).
- Obtaining screens for artistic silk screen printing (MF2102_2).
- Printing in artistic silk screen printing (MF2103_2).
- Practical training at the workplace in artistic silk screen printing (MP0472)

(See legal basis for all learning outcomes information acquired by the holder of this Certificate in each MF).

As a reference the learning outcomes include in the Practical training at the workplace that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:

- Participate in the choice of appropriate technique for creating the image on the screen, according to the graphic work to be made.
- Collaborate in the choice of appropriate technique for creating the stencils or transparencies, according to the graphic work to be made.
- Participate in the choice of appropriate technique for creating the silk screen printing screen, according to the graphic work to be made.
- Collaborate in the process of printing silk screen prints, according to the equipment, medium to be printed and ink to be used.
- Take part in the company's working processes, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of this certificate may work in graphic arts companies with artistic silk screen printing departments, and in artistic printing workshops. The holder may work in the graphic arts sector, the sub-sector of artistic silk screen printing, and in any productive sector whose companies require a graphics department to create screen prints.

The most pertinent occupations and positions are:

- Silk screen printing artist.
- Artistic silk screen printer.
- Artistic silk screen printing screen operator.
- Artistic silk screen printer.
- Artistic silk screen technical adviser.

5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE
<p>Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.</p>
<p>Level of the certificate The Professional Certificate Level 2 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 3 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011). The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:</p>
<p>Grading scale/Pass requirements The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module. The grading system is as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - FAIL: 0 to 4.9 - PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9 - PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9 - PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10
<p>Access to next level of education/training This Professional Certificate Level 2 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 3 within the same professional area and family. For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.</p>
<p>Legal basis Royal Decree 612/2013 of 2 August, establishing seven professional certificates in the professional family Graphic Arts, which are included in the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates. (Appendix IV, Code: ARGA0311)</p>

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE		
<p>This certificate may be acquired by:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme. 2. Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate. 3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate. <p>The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:</p>

Entry/access requirements:

- Compulsory Secondary Education Diploma (Lower secondary education); or
- Professional Certificate Level 1 in the same professional area.
- If neither of the above or higher certifications are held, a pass in the key skills tests.

Additional information: Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
