## 3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to improve customers' personal image, applying hairstyling techniques and protocols for hair care and beauty together with complementary techniques for styling and shaving beards and moustaches, under optimal quality, health and safety conditions. This general competence is divided into the following **skills units** (UC):

- Perform hair analysis to design technical protocols and apply hair beauty care treatments (UC0347\_2).
- Prepare equipment and wash and condition hair and scalp (UC0058\_1).
- Perform total or partial hair colour changes (UC0348\_2).
- Temporarily hairstyle changes, final dress and/or updo it (UC0349\_2).
- Perform permanent hair style changes (UC0350\_2).
- Cut hair and trim and shave beards and moustaches (UC0351\_2).
- Provide advice on and sell personal image products and services (UC0352\_2)

The professional skills are acquired through the **learning outcomes** defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Analysis of scalp and hair, technical work and hair care protocols (MF0347\_2).
- Hygiene and asepsis applied to hairstyling (MF0058\_1).
- Hair colouring (MF0348\_2).
- Hairstyles, dress and updos (MF0349\_2).
- Permanent hairstyle changes (MF0350\_2).
- Haircuts and complementary techniques (MF0351\_2).
- Advice on and sale of personal image products and services (MF0352\_2).
- Practical training at the workplace in Hairdressing (MP0115)

(See legal basis for all learning outcomes information acquired by the holder of this Certificate in each MF).

As a reference the learning outcomes include in the Practical training at the workplace that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:

- Examine customer hair and scalp condition to adapt technical and beauty care to customer characteristics.
- Select and prepare equipment, tools, materials, accessories and cosmetics to perform technical hairstyling tasks.
- Apply beauty care to scalp and hair alterations according to diagnosis and under health and safety conditions, skillfully using necessary technical means.
- Apply colouring or bleaching techniques adapting them to customer characteristics and demands.
- Perform techniques for temporary hairstyle change using the most appropriate means and products.
- Perform permanent hairstyle techniques adapted to customer's characteristics and demands under health and safety conditions.
- Perform various haircut techniques and styles according to customer characteristics and demands, complying with necessary health and safety standards.
- Perform beard and moustache shaving and trimming techniques, under health and safety conditions according to customer's characteristics, following skilfully techniques.
- Apply adequate techniques for the promotion and sale of personal image products and services.
- Evaluate the process and outcomes of the hairstyling services, proposing any changes necessary to obtain expected results.
- Take part in the company's working processes, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.

## 4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of this certificate may work in companies providing hairstyling services as an employee or self-employed and in the promotion and sale of hairstyling products. The holder may also work in personal image services, hotels, spas, hospitals, social services, nursing homes, personal services and gymnasiums. The most pertinent occupations and positions are:

- Ladies hairdresser.
- Men's hairstylist.
- Unisex hairstylist.
- Hairdressing product salesperson.

## 5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE

### Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate

The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.

### Level of the certificate

The Professional Certificate Level 2 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 3 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).

The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:

### Grading scale/Pass requirements

The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module.

The grading system is as follows:

- FAIL: 0 to 4.9
- PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9
- PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9
- PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10

### Access to next level of education/training

This Professional Certificate Level 2 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 3 within the same professional area and family.

For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.

### Legal basis

Royal Decree 716/2011 of 20 May, establishing five professional certificates in the professional family Personal Image, which are included in the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates. (Appendix I, Code: IMPQ0208).

## 6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

This certificate may be acquired by:

1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme.
2. Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate.
3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate.

The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training

at the workplace:

**Entry/access requirements:**

- Compulsory Secondary Education Diploma (Lower secondary education); or
- Professional Certificate Level 1 in the same professional area.
- If neither of the above or higher certifications are held, a pass in the key skills tests.

**Additional information:** Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
