3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to carry out operations of installation, assembly, adjustment and finishing of light or heavy-framed and large-sectioned constructions, trunks, glulam and panelling systems, in conditions of occupational health and safety. This general competence is divided into the following **skills units** (UC):

- Interpret technical documentation, prepare equipment and receive material for wood constructions (UC1357_2).
- Have the human, technical and auxiliary installations available in the different assembly phases of wood constructions (UC1358_2).
- Carry out the processes of assembly and installation of wood constructions (UC1359_2).
- Control risks in construction at a basic level (UC1360_2).
- Apply surface finishing products to carpentry and furniture using mechanical/manual means (UC0167_1).

The professional skills are acquired through the **learning outcomes** defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Technical documentation, equipment and material for wood constructions (MF1357_2).
- Resources and installations in wood constructions (MF1358_2).
- Wood construction processes (MF1359_2).
- Basic occupational risk prevention in construction (MF1360_2).
- Application of surface finishing products in carpentry and furniture (MF0167_1).
- Practical training at the workplace in assembly and installation of wood constructions (MP0303)

As a reference the learning outcomes include in the Practical training at the workplace that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:

- Receive materials and products in accordance with the documentation on a specific wood construction, selecting the machines, tools, utensils and auxiliary means needed for construction, taking into account the safety measures, risk prevention and signposting in the workplace.
- Define the assembly plan of a specific wood construction in accordance with the documentation provided, indicating the requirements in terms of personnel, product, material, machinery and equipment.
- Carry out the assembly of a specific wood construction in accordance with a defined project.
- Finish the elements of a wood construction in accordance with a specific project.
- Take part in the company's working processes, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of this certificate may work in companies dedicated to the manufacture, installation and assembly of light or heavy framed or large-sectioned wood structures, glulam, trunks and panel systems, in the sectors of manufacture and installation of wood constructions, installations in wood construction work, structural woodworking and restoration of wood structures. The most pertinent occupations and positions are:

- Assembler/installer of wood constructions.
- Assembly worker in wood constructions.
- Applier of finishing.
- Wood construction restoration and maintenance worker
- Structural woodworker in construction.

The certificate is valid throughout Spain.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Level of the certificate</p> <p>The Professional Certificate Level 2 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 3 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).</p> <p>The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Grading scale/Pass requirements</p> <p>The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module.</p> <p>The grading system is as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - FAIL: 0 to 4.9 - PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9 - PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9 - PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10
<p style="text-align: center;">Access to next level of education/training</p> <p>This Professional Certificate Level 2 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 3 within the same professional area and family.</p> <p>For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Legal basis</p> <p>Royal Decree 1532/2011 of 31 October, establishing seven professional certificates in the professional family Wood, Furniture and Cork, which are included in the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates. (Appendix IV, Code: MAMB0210)</p>

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE		
<p>This certificate may be acquired by:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme. 2. Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate. 3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate. <p>The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:</p>

Entry/access requirements:

- Compulsory Secondary Education Diploma (Lower secondary education); or
- Professional Certificate Level 1 in the same professional area.
- If neither of the above or higher certifications are held, a pass in the key skills tests.

Additional information: Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
