3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to train dogs using training methods and modify unwanted behaviours to achieve social harmony, according to the requirements of the owner and/or responsible person and do dog's hygienic care and first aid services to it, taking into account occupational risks prevention and animal welfare standards. This general competence is divided into the following **skill units**(UC):

- Train the dog with basic training methodologies (UC1741_2).
- Modify unwanted behaviours (UC1742_2).
- Undertake canine care and hygiene tasks (UC1743_2).
- Apply first aid services to dogs (UC1744_2).

The professional skills are acquired through the **learning outcomes** defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Application of basic training methodologies to dogs (MF1741_2).
- Modification of unwanted behaviours in dogs (MF1742_2).
- Application of hygienic care to dogs (MF1743_2).
- First aids applied to dogs (MF1744_2).
- Practical training at the workplace in basic training and canine education (MP0568).

As a reference the learning outcomes include in the Practical training at the workplace that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:

- Participate, with a responsible person, in the implementation of basic control, obedience, and obstacle overcoming exercises to dogs by applying a predetermined work program, following the rules and procedures of the workplace.
- Participate in maintaining areas of accommodation and transport of dogs, following the rules and procedures in the workplace to ensure health and hygiene conditions of them.
- Participate in the working processes of the company, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of this certificate exercises his/her activity in the service sector linked to training and education of dogs associated with production activities related to: canine accommodation, recovery and reproduction centers, dog training centers, dog breeds clubs, companies and/or entities associated with security, civil protection and recreational and sports activities related to the canine world. The most relevant occupations and work positions are:

- Dog trainer.
- Canine trainer-educator.
- Assistant to dog adoption centers.
- Kennels assistant.
- Assistant to dog shops.
- Assistant to Canine residences.

5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE

Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate

The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.

Level of the certificate

The Professional Certificate Level 2 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 3 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).

The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:

Grading scale/Pass requirements

The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module.

The grading system is as follows:

- FAIL: 0 to 4.9
- PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9
- PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9
- PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10

Access to next level of education/training

This Professional Certificate Level 2 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 3 within the same professional area and family.

For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.

Legal basis

Royal Decree 548/2014 of June 27th, by which five professional certificates of the professional family Security and Environment, included in the National Repertoire of professional certificates are established, and two professional certificates of the professional family Information and Communications Technology, established in Royal Decree 1531/2011, of October 31st and Royal Decree 686/2011, of May 13th, modified by Royal Decree 628/2013, of August 2nd are updated. 6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

This certificate may be acquired by:

1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme.
2. Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate.
3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate.

The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:

Entry/access requirements:

- Compulsory Secondary Education Diploma (Lower secondary education); or
- Professional Certificate Level 1 in the same professional area.
- If neither of the above or higher certifications are held, a pass in the key skills tests.

Additional information: Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
