3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to prepare, transport and apply resources and products designed to control pests in conditions of health and safety This general competence is divided into the following **skills units** (UC):

- Prepare and transport pest control resources and products (UC0078_2).
- Apply pest control resources and products (UC0079_2).
- Adopt occupational risk prevention measures at the workplace (UC0075_2).

The professional skills are acquired through the **learning outcomes** defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Preparation of biocides and phytosanitary products (MF0078_2).
- Application of pest control resources and products (MF0079_2).
- Safety and health (MF0075_2)
- Practical training at the workplace in pest control services (MP00322)

(See legal basis for all learning outcomes information acquired by the holder of this Certificate in each MF).

As a reference the learning outcomes include in the Practical training at the workplace that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:

- Store biocides and phytosanitary products.
- Prepare the products and resources needed for the treatment.
- Inspect and locate arthropods, rats and mice or other species in buildings and gardens.
- Apply methods of direct non-chemical pest control.
- Carry out treatment by applying chemical pest control products.
- Take part in the company's working processes, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of this certificate may work in pest control services in the natural and urban environment and in establishments of pesticide and phytosanitary products. The holder may work in disinfection, rodent control and disinfestation companies, whether establishments dealing in products or the application services; in the chemical sector and in gardening, agriculture, livestock farming and forestry activities.

The most pertinent occupations and positions are:

- Pesticide applier.
- Fumigator.
- Building disinfector/disinfestator.
- Public health activities.
- Pest control applier.
- Biocides applicator treatments for TP2, 3, 4, 14, 18 and 19.

This professional certificate is legally required for the provision of biocide treatments type (PT) 2, 3, 4, 14, 18 and 19 according to the Royal Decree 830/2010 of 25th of June of the Ministry of Health.

5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE

Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate

The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.

Level of the certificate

The Professional Certificate Level 2 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 3 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).

The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:

Grading scale/Pass requirements

The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module.

The grading system is as follows:

- FAIL: 0 to 4.9
- PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9
- PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9
- PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10

Access to next level of education/training

This Professional Certificate Level 2 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 3 within the same professional area and family.

For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.

Legal basis

Royal Decree 1536/2011 of 31 October, establishing two professional certificates in the professional family Safety and the Environment, which are included in the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates.

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

This certificate may be acquired by:

1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme.
2. Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate.
3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate.

The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:

Entry/access requirements:

- Compulsory Secondary Education Diploma (Lower secondary education); or
- Professional Certificate Level 1 in the same professional area.
- If neither of the above or higher certifications are held, a pass in the key skills tests.

Additional information: Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
