3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to carry out illustrations projects developing sketches using visual-graphic techniques, considering documentation selected according to the order requirements, and following logical and progressive construction of drawings/images, creating the originals and making the final art, preparing them for broadcast, publication and/or reproduction, managing legal and economic aspects of the project and controlling the quality process. This general competence is divided into the following **skill units** (UC):

- Define the illustration project (UC2230_3).
- Prepare the documentation dossier for the illustration work (UC2231_3).
- Perform sketching illustrations by visual-graphic art techniques (UC2232_3).
- Make original illustrations (UC2233_3).
- Perform the illustration final art (UC2234_3).
- Organize and manage the graphic arts workshop or studio (UC2229_3).

The professional skills are acquired through the **learning outcomes** defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Illustrations projects (MF2230_3).
- Documentation processes for illustration projects (MF2231_3).
- Visual-graphic techniques for illustration sketches (MF2232_3).
- Development of original illustrations (MF2233_3).
- Preparation of original illustrations for broadcast (MF2234_3).
- Organization and management of a graphic arts workshop or studio (MF2229_3).
- Practical training at the workplace in illustrations (MP0571).

As a reference the learning outcomes include in the Practical training at the workplace that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:

- Define the illustration project and its budget.
- Assist in the elaboration of a dossier of documentation for an illustration project.
- Participate in the processes of sketching of an illustrations project.
- Collaborate in developing the analog and/or digital originals of an illustration.
- Participate in the processes of final art and monitoring of the artwork edition.
- Participate in the working processes of the company, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of this certificate works in the audiovisual sector, publicity, fashion or in any other sector in which the realization of illustrations is required. They can be part of illustrations departments in companies or institutions, generally work performing orders for companies inside their influence or personal projects that offer such companies.

The most relevant occupations and work positions are:

- Graphic artists for press.
- Cartoonist.
- Illustrator.
- Artist-editor.
- Billboard illustrator.

5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE

Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate

The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.

Level of the certificate

The Professional Certificate Level 3 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 4 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).

The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:

Grading scale/Pass requirements

The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module.

The grading system is as follows:

- FAIL: 0 to 4.9
- PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9
- PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9
- PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10

Access to next level of education/training

This Professional Certificate Level 3 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 3 within the same professional area and family.

For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.

Legal basis

Royal Decree 984/2013 of December 13th, by which seven professional certificates of the professional family "Graphic arts", included in the National Repertoire of professional certificates are established, and the professional certificate established as Appendix II of the Royal Decree 612/2013, of August 2nd is updated. (Appendix IV, Code: ARGG0212)

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

This certificate may be acquired by:

1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme.
2. Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate.
3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate.

The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:

Entry/access requirements:

- *Bachiller* Diploma (upper secondary education); or
- Professional Certificate Level 2 in the same professional area.
- If neither of the above or higher certifications are held, a pass in the key skills tests.

Additional information: Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
