3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to beautify and care for skin applying various methods of: tanning, electrical epilation, photo-depilation, micropigmentation and social makeup styles, and using procedures for sale of and advice on beauty products and services, complying with safety and health standards. This general competence is divided into the following **skills units** (UC):

- Perform artificial tanning techniques under health and safety conditions (UC0580 3).
- Perform permanent depilation and/or supervise temporary depilation procedures (UC0581_3).
- Improve facial harmony with social makeup styles (UC0065 2).
- Perform and supervise micropigmentation processes (UC0067_3).
- Provide advice on and sell personal image products and services (UC0352_2).

The professional skills are acquired through the **learning outcomes** defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Artificial tanning (MF0580 3).
- Hair depilation with temporary and/or permanent methods (MF0581_3).
- Social makeup (MF0065 2).
- Micropigmentation (MF0067 3).
- Advice on and sale of personal image products and services (MF0352 2).
- Practical training at the workplace in monitoring of tanning, makeup and advanced depilation (MP0243)

As a reference the learning outcomes include in the Practical training at the workplace that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:

- Analyse customer anatomical structures and anatomical-physiological skin status related to application of artificial tanning.
- Provide tanning service under health and safety conditions in accordance with applicable regulations.
- Apply face and body depilation techniques with tweezers and wax.
- Apply electrical depilation techniques under optimal health and safety conditions.
- Apply laser depilation and photo-depilation techniques under health and safety conditions.
- Take part in the company's working processes, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.
- Apply different styles of social makeup according to beauty characteristics, age, personality and situation in which it is to be worn and under optimal health and safety conditions.
- Analyse skin characteristics and status to propose possible corrections with micropigmentation, identifying possible contraindications and indications for preparing and caring for the skin.
- Apply and collaborate in micropigmentation techniques adapting technical means to the desired effects.
- Apply adequate techniques for the promotion and sale of personal image products and services.
- Evaluate artificial tanning, depilation, social makeup, micropigmentation and consultancy and sale processes and assess results achieved in order to propose, if necessary, measures to improve service quality.
- Take part in the company's working processes, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of this certificate may work in beauty and hairstyling companies as an employee or self-employed: beauty salons and in the hairstyling and beauty areas of hotels, gymnasiums, nursing homes and spas. The holder may also work in the beauty and hairstyling services sector.

The most pertinent occupations and positions are:

- Makeup artist
- Depilation specialist.
- Micropigmentation specialist.
- Tanning equipment operator.
- Salesperson of personal image products and services.

5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE

Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate

The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.

Level of the certificate

The Professional Certificate Level 3 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 4 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).

The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:

Grading scale/Pass requirements

The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module.

The grading system is as follows:

FAIL: 0 to 4.9

PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9

PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10

Access to next level of education/training

This Professional Certificate Level 3 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 3 within the same professional area and family.

For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.

Legal basis

Royal Decree 716/2011 of 20 May, establishing five professional certificates in the professional family Personal Image, which are included in the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates. Appendix II, Code: IMPE0109.

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

This certificate may be acquired by:

- 1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme.
- 2. Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate.
- 3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate.

The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:

Entry/access requirements:

- Bachiller Diploma (upper secondary education); or
- Professional Certificate Level 2 in the same professional area.
- If neither of the above or higher certifications are held, a pass in the key skills tests.

Additional information: Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
