## 3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to apply makeup, micropigmentation and tattooing techniques in optimum conditions of hygiene and safety for the customer, the environment and the circumstances. This general competence is divided into the following **skills units** (UC):

- Prepare the technical and personal resources for applying comprehensive makeup (UC0064\_2).
- Improve facial harmony with social makeup styles (UC0065\_2).
- Apply makeup for stage and audiovisual productions (UC0066\_2).
- Perform and supervise micropigmentation processes (UC0067\_3).
- Perform and supervise artistic tattooing techniques (UC0068\_3).

The professional skills are acquired through the **learning outcomes** defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Safety and health in comprehensive makeup (MF0064\_2).
  - Social makeup (MF0065\_2).
  - Makeup for stage and audiovisual productions (MF0066\_2).
  - Micropigmentation (MF0067\_3).
  - Tattooing (MF0068\_3).
  - Practical training at the workplace in monitoring of comprehensive makeup (MP0258)
- (See legal basis for all learning outcomes information acquired by the holder of this Certificate in each MF).  
As a reference the learning outcomes include in the Practical training at the workplace that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:
- Select and prepare the facilities, cosmetics, materials and tools needed for the comprehensive makeup services, applying appropriate hygiene and disinfection rules.
  - Apply social makeup in different styles, in accordance with features, age, personality characteristics and the circumstances in which they will be seen, under optimum hygiene and safety conditions.
  - Apply methods for the analysis of people's physical characteristics, relating them to the comprehensive makeup techniques that must be applied.
  - Apply different types of makeup, adapting them to the technical characteristics of the medium, person and character.
  - Apply drawing techniques to facial and body fantasy makeup, applying cosmetics and other materials to achieve the proposed results.
  - Analyse skin characteristics and state, to propose corrections with micropigmentation and/or tattooing, identifying possible contraindications and indications for preparing and caring for the skin.
  - Analyse the different types of lines in the face and the possible corrections of hair styling to suit the shape of the face.
  - Analyse the applications of imitation natural colour in the hair, pubic area, areolae, scars, vitiligo, burnt skin and other discolorations, and correct them.
  - Perform or collaborate in micropigmentation techniques, adapting the technical means to the required effects.
  - Evaluate the quality of the processes of comprehensive makeup, applying techniques to detect the level of customer satisfaction, proposing corrective measures for any deviations from expected results.
  - Take part in the company's working processes, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.

## 4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of this certificate may work in companies offering beauty treatment, cosmetic medicine and surgery, tattooing, the audiovisual sector, theatre, fashion shows, and as advisor and demonstrator for manufacturers and distributors of products and/or equipment. The work may be in productive sectors operating in the area of beauty treatments, the stage and audiovisual productions, manufacture and distribution of products, cosmetics and tools.

The most pertinent occupations and positions are:

- Makeup artist.
- Tattoo artist.
- Micropigmentation artist.
- Tattooist.

## 5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE

### Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate

The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.

### Level of the certificate

The Professional Certificate Level 3 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 4 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).

The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:

### Grading scale/Pass requirements

The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module.

The grading system is as follows:

- FAIL: 0 to 4.9
- PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9
- PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9
- PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10

### Access to next level of education/training

This Professional Certificate Level 3 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 3 within the same professional area and family.

For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.

### Legal basis

Royal Decree 716/2011 of 20 May, establishing five professional certificates in the professional family Personal Image, which are included in the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates. (Appendix III, Code: IMPE0209).

## 6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

This certificate may be acquired by:

1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme.
2. Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate.
3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate.

The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:

### Entry/access requirements:

- *Bachiller* Diploma (upper secondary education); or
- Professional Certificate Level 2 in the same professional area.
- If neither of the above or higher certifications are held, a pass in the key skills tests.

**Additional information:** Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
