## 3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder of this certificate will have acquired the **general competence** to characterize characters for the audiovisual media and theatre, preparing projects for characters designing according to artistic projects and technical, economic and human factors involved, planning and coordinating the work of professionals working in the process, preparing sketches and using hairdressing styles, wigs, hairpieces and extension, makeup, prostheses and special effect through makeup techniques following health and safety regulations. This general competence is divided into the following **skills units (UC)**:

- Prepare projects for characters design according to artistic projects (UC1254\_3).
- Plan, organise and manage projects for characters designing (UC1255\_3).
- Apply makeup for theatrical and audiovisual artistic projects (UC0066\_2).
- Make facial and body prostheses for characters' project design (UC1256\_3).
- Make hair prostheses for characters' design (UC1257\_3).
- Apply hairstyling techniques for characters' design (UC1258\_2).
- Design characters and special makeup effects (UC1259\_3).

The professional skills are acquired through the **learning outcomes** defined within the related Training Modules (MF):

- Characterization projects (MF1254\_3).
- Planning and management of characterization projects (MF1255\_3).
- Makeup for theatrical and audiovisual projects (MF0066\_2).
- Facial and body prostheses for characterization (MF1256\_3).
- Hair prostheses for characterization (MF1257\_3).
- Hairdressing for characterization (MF1258\_2).
- Characterization and special makeup effects (MF1259\_3).
- Practical training at the workplace module in Characterization of characters (MP0435)

As a reference the learning outcomes include in the Practical training at the workplace that complete and reinforce the learning outcomes acquired in the other training modules, are:

- Select materials, products, tools and techniques for character design according to the character, the characteristics of the technical environment and the interpreter, integrating them in the character design project.
- Take care of and maintain the tools, apparatus, materials and products for character design, guaranteeing adequate hygiene and safety conditions.
- Apply techniques of preparing and protecting the person whose character is to be designed with the requirements of the products and techniques employed in making prostheses.
- Make the prostheses used in character design.
- Design the prostheses used in character design.
- Apply techniques for temporarily changes to hair form and colour, wigs and hairpieces as appropriate in the process of character design.
- Apply the techniques of colouring and adapting prostheses and elements for character design, taking into account the characteristics of the design.
- Apply different types of makeup, adapting them to the technical characteristics of the medium, person and character.
- Retouch and make changes to the characters, according to the technical documentation and resolving any unforeseen circumstances that may arise in live performances and audiovisual productions, achieving the

desired results.

- Apply the technical means required to remove the prostheses and characterisation elements in conditions of safety, in accordance with the requirements of the process.
- Apply techniques for the maintenance, repair and storage of the materials and tools used in character design, according to the needs of these processes.
- Apply management techniques in the work activities of the teams involved in the process of character design.
- Take part in the company's working processes, following the rules and instructions established at the workplace.

### 4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

The holder of this certificate may work as a character designer in public and private makeup enterprises, hairpiece workshops, prosthetic workshops, cinema, TV, stage productions, advertising or fashion shows. The work is in the service sector, mainly related to stage and audiovisual productions, where there character design is required; and also in advertising, fashion, and cultural and leisure events. The most pertinent occupations and positions are:

- Characters' designer.
- Makeup artist.
- Makeup manager for audiovisual media and theatrical activities and productions.
- Hairdresser for live performances.
- Hairdresser for the audiovisual media.
- Makeup artistic professional for the audiovisual media and live activities and productions.
- Hairpiece stylist.
- Prosthesis maker.
- Character design Manager.
- Head of hairdressing for audiovisual events and media companies.

### 5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE

#### **Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate**

The Ministry of Employment and Social Security or the corresponding autonomous regional administration within the scope of its competence, in the name of the King. The certificate is valid throughout Spain.

#### **Level of the certificate**

The Professional Certificate Level 3 of the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates corresponds to level 4 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED-P 2011).

The European Qualification Framework (EQF) level:

#### **Grading scale/Pass requirements**

The grading scale and pass level of the training modules are expressed on a scale of 0 to 10. The minimum score for a pass is 5 in every training module including a pass in the practical training at the workplace module.

The grading system is as follows:

- FAIL: 0 to 4.9
- PASS-SATISFACTORY: 5 to 6.9
- PASS-GOOD: 7 to 8.9
- PASS-EXCELLENT: 9 to 10

#### **Access to next level of education/training**

This Professional Certificate Level 3 gives access to Professional Certificate Level 3 within the same professional area and family.

For validation purposes, the educational authorities will recognise the professional module or modules of the VET diplomas corresponding to the skills units included in the training modules of this certificate.

## 5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE

### Legal basis

Royal Decree 620/2013 of 2 August, establishing two professional certificates in the professional family Personal Image, which are included in the National Repertoire of Professional Certificates. (Appendix II, Code: IMPE0211).

## 6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

This certificate may be acquired by:

1. Training: Completion with a pass grade of the face-to-face or online training programme.
2. Recognition of the professional skills acquired through professional experience or non-formal training (prior learning): Completion of a process of skills evaluation and accreditation in all the skills units making up the professional certificate.
3. Dual training: Completion of a training and apprenticeship contract, which may range from 1 year (or 6 months, if stipulated as such in the collective agreement) to 3 years, during which effective working time is combined with time dedicated to training under the training programme for the professional certificate.

The training method (number 1 above) requires successful completion of the training modules and the practical training at the workplace:

### Entry/access requirements:

- *Bachiller* Diploma (upper secondary education); or
- Professional Certificate Level 2 in the same professional area.
- If neither of the above or higher certifications are held, a pass in the key skills tests.

**Additional information:** Professional certificates are instruments for official accreditation of the professional qualifications in the National Catalogue of Professional Qualifications for all economic activities, within the scope of the labour administration. The National Repertoire of Professional Certificates is divided into three qualification levels (Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3), and by sectors into 26 professional families and 102 professional areas.
